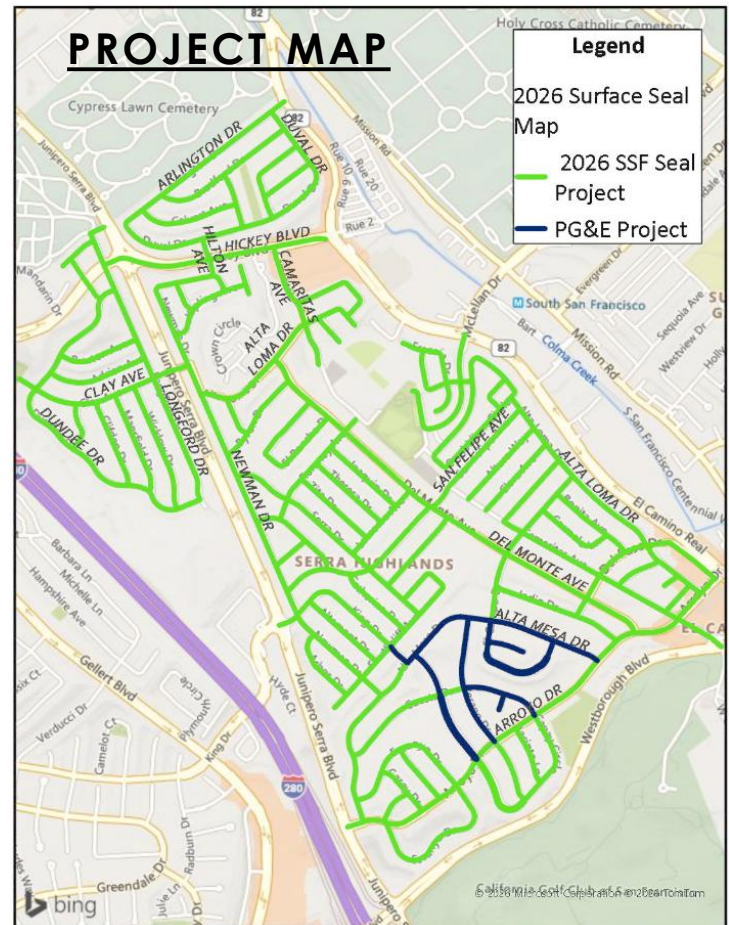
2026 STREET SURFACE SEAL PROJECT

Notice of an upcoming construction project in your neighborhood focused on preserving roadway conditions and extending pavement life.

This work will enhance street quality, improve neighborhood appearance, and support a safer and more connected transportation network throughout the City.

The Project includes:

1. **Structural Repairs** – Repairing damaged pavement prior to sealing through localized base repairs and crack sealing to prevent water infiltration and further pavement deterioration.
2. **Surface Treatment** – Applying a slurry seal to protect the roadway from sun exposure and moisture, extend pavement life, and improve skid resistance.
3. **Safety Striping** – Replacing worn pavement markings with new, high-visibility striping and pavement markings to improve safety for all roadway users.



Phase 1: LOCALIZED BASE REPAIRS

Crews identify and fix specific areas of damaged pavement before the sealing begins.

Phase 2: CRACK SEALING AND PREP

Existing cracks are sealed and old pavement markings are removed to ensure a clean surface.

Phase 3: SURFACE SEAL & NEW STRIPING

Slurry seal is applied, followed by new high-visibility lane striping and refreshed curbs.

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WHAT TO EXPECT...

- Construction is expected to begin in mid-July 2026 and continue over the following several months.
- Construction hours will be Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
- Affected households will receive door hangers or notices before construction begins on their street.
- On-street parking and sidewalk access may be temporarily impacted during construction.
- Temporary "No Parking" signs and detours will be posted in advance of work activities.
- Expect delays and please follow all posted signs and crew instructions for your safety.



HOW YOU CAN HELP...



- **OBSERVE "NO PARKING" RULES**

Look for temporary "No Parking" signs posted at least 72 hours in advance. Vehicles must be moved to avoid towing and construction delays.



- **FOLLOW ROAD CLOSURES & DETOURS**

Expect temporary lane closures, road closures, and detours during construction activities. Please allow extra travel time and follow all posted traffic control signs.



- **STAY OFF FRESH SURFACES**

Do not drive, park, walk, or bike on freshly sealed roadways until they are officially reopened. This helps prevent damage to the new surface and avoids tracking seal coat materials onto private property.
