NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING FOR FEE INCREASE**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the City Council of the City of South San Francisco will hold a Public Hearing at a Regular Meeting on **Wednesday, May 13, 2026**, commencing at **6:30 p.m.**, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, in the Council Chambers, at the Library Parks & Recreation Building, 901 Civic Campus Way, South San Francisco, California, on items, including consideration of the following, at which time and place any and all persons interested may appear and be heard thereon. The Council may continue the hearing from time to time without further written notice.

**Revisions to Master Fee Schedule for Fiscal Year 2026-2027**

The City Council will hold a public hearing to consider adoption of a resolution adopting a revised Master Fee Schedule for fiscal year 2026-2027. The Master Fee Schedule establishes fees for a broad range of services performed by the City, including fees imposed upon development projects pursuant to Government Code section 66017. The Master Fee Schedule proposes to increase the amount of certain existing fees, although all of the fees contained in the Master Fee Schedule are equal to or less than the reasonable cost to the City of providing the relevant service.

In accordance with Government Code Section 66016, the proposed Master Fee Schedule will be available for public inspection, review, and comment for ten (10) days prior to the public hearing at which the City Council will consider the Resolution. The proposed Master Fee Schedule may be viewed in the Office of the City Clerk at South San Francisco City Hall, 400 Grand Avenue.

Written correspondence may be submitted to the attention of the City Council, at the address below.

If you challenge in court the action taken by the City Council regarding the item described above, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice of in written correspondence delivered to the City Council at, or prior to, the public hearings.
