General Elections Around the Corner!

Election season is here! The City of South San Francisco will hold its General Municipal Election on November 3, 2026. Voters will have the opportunity to elect representatives for City Council Districts 1, 3, and 5, as well as the City Clerk and City Treasurer positions.

Interested in serving your community? The candidate nomination period opens July 13, 2026, and closes August 7, 2026, at 5:00 p.m. Eligible candidates must be at least 18 years old, registered to vote, and reside within the City (and within the applicable district for City Council seats).

Virtual Public Comments Available Now!

Starting July 8, 2026, members of the public will have a new way to participate in City Council meetings. In addition to attending in person, community members will be able to provide public comment remotely through Zoom during Regular City Council meetings.

Participants may join by computer, smartphone, or telephone and can use the "Raise Hand" feature when they wish to speak on an agenda item. When called upon, speakers will be invited to provide comments within the allotted speaking time.
