Get Involved: Learn About South San Francisco's Boards & Commissions

Did you know that South San Francisco residents can help shape local policies, programs, and services by serving on a City Board, Commission, or Committee?

Boards and Commissions are advisory bodies made up of community members who provide recommendations to the City Council on a variety of important issues. These groups help ensure that resident voices are part of the decision-making process and play a valuable role in strengthening community engagement, transparency, and civic participation.

The City currently has vacancies on the following advisory bodies:

- Equity & Public Safety Commission – 1 Alternate Seat
- Library Board – 1 Vacant Seat
- Measure W Citizens' Oversight Committee – 2 Vacant Seats and 1 Alternate Seat
- Parking Place Commission - 1 Vacant Seat (*member to serve on Traffic Advisory Committee*)
- Parks & Recreation Commission - 1 Vacant Seat

Residents interested in serving their community are encouraged to apply!

Serving on a Board or Commission is a meaningful way to contribute your expertise, represent community interests, and help shape the future of South San Francisco.

What do these Boards & Commissions do?

Equity & Public Safety Commission

Provides recommendations on policies and practices that impact equity, community safety, and public services throughout the City.

Library Board

Works with the Library Director to help guide library services, programs, and policies that support lifelong learning and community enrichment.

Measure W Citizens' Oversight Committee

Reviews independent audits and expenditures related to Measure W revenues to help ensure accountability and transparency in the use of voter-approved funds.

Parking Place Commission

Oversees matters related to parking facilities within the City's downtown Parking District and advises on parking operations, management, and enforcement. Commissioners also serve on the Traffic Safety Commission, providing recommendations on traffic facilities, planning, and transportation-related improvements throughout the City.

Parks & Recreation Commission

Advises the City Council on parks, playgrounds, recreation programs, and community services while helping support the planning of recreational opportunities and facilities for residents.
