The Inspire Sculpture runs entirely on wind power?


The movement of the individual circles is completely run by wind power. There are no motors. Each circle is perfectly balanced so that they would move with the slightest air currents. Under the most severe wind conditions, as the circles start to turn faster, centrifugal force will flatten out their positions and thus minimize surface area. Inspire is fabricated entirely in Stainless Steel and stands at 24' high with the pedestal. Come see the new sculpture designed by Jonathan Russell and Saori Ide of Ride Art Studio at the new Karyl Matsumoto Plaza on Airport and Grand.



It's important to find out what brands and model numbers are eligible for rebate before you shop for appliances or fixtures. Qualified products are listed on their website.
