ARREST- Attempted Murder

On 01/24/2026 at approximately 12:16 A.M. South San Francisco Police Officers responded to the 300 block of Grand Avenue on the report of a subject who had been stabbed in the back. When officers arrived, they located an adult male subject who was suffering from a stab wound. South San Francisco Fire Department personnel provided the victim with medical aid and transported him to a local trauma center where it was determined he sustained a non-life-threatening injury. The suspect in the case had fled the scene after the incident, and through the investigation, Detectives were able to positively identify him as 36-year-old Morgan Hallquist out of Brisbane. On 01/28/2026, Detectives located and apprehended Hallquist in Brisbane at which time they also recovered further evidence of the crime. Hallquist was later booked into San Mateo County Jail without incident.
