DEMONSTRATION PROJECT

The City of South San Francisco is working to prepare a demonstration project that will be in place for up to three weeks to investigate and analyze the impacts, benefits, and challenges of converting School Street in front of Martin Elementary (between Olive Ave and Maple Ave) to a one-way operation.


This project is being implemented as a result of feedback received from local residents and Martin Elementary staff and students to consider making this segment a one-way street for safer walking and biking to and from school. As part of this demonstration the City will collect traffic data to analyze impacts and assess long term feasibility. The feedback received from this short-term demonstration project will be evaluated and will help the City determine if the one-way operation can be implemented permanently.

The proposed operational change would also include minor physical improvements to encourage compliance, such as temporary barriers and signage.

TIMELINE

The City is looking to conduct the demonstration from August 25th through September 12th.
