ARREST- Pimping & Pandering

On 10/16/2025, detectives and officers partnered with NCRIC (Northern California Regional Intelligence Center) and participated in a nationwide human trafficking initiative, Operation Coast to Coast. The operation aimed to identify victims of human trafficking and arrest traffickers. During the operation multiple victims of human trafficking were contacted and provided resources and services.

During one of the contacts, a 30-year-old female human trafficking victim was contacted at a hotel room on the 300 block of South Airport Boulevard. A male subject also contacted and identified as 34-year-old Denzel Simmons out of Pittsburg, California. Simmons was found to be in violation of pimping and pandering and was also found to be in possession of a firearm during the commission of a felony. Simmons was booked into the San Mateo County Jail without incident.

The victim was provided resources from the San Mateo County District Attorney's Office Victim Services Division.

The ongoing partnership between the South San Francisco Police Department, NCRIC, and the San Mateo County District Attorney's Office Victim Services Division is vital to the continued effort to identify, support, and protect victims of human trafficking.
