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Fireworks Seizure

On February 12, 2025, at 10:00AM, the South San Francisco Police Department responded to a storage facility on Oyster Point Boulevard on a report of a large amount of dangerous fireworks located inside of a storage unit. Upon arrival, officers observed over 5,000 pounds of fireworks, valued at over \$300,000.00. The South San Francisco Fire Department and San Mateo County Sheriff's Office Bomb Squad responded to the scene to assist with the collection and safe storage of the fireworks. There is currently no risk to public safety, and this is an active and ongoing investigation.
